The Mind of Christ

1 Corinthians 2:16

Believers have access to the mind of Christ. God gives spiritual understanding so His people can discern truth and walk in wisdom.

Philippians 2:5

God calls believers to adopt the attitude and mindset of Jesus—humility, obedience, and trust in the Father.

A Renewed Mind

Romans 12:2

Transformation comes through renewing the mind with God's truth. When our thinking changes, our lives begin to change.

Ephesians 4:23

God continually renews the spirit of our mind as we walk with Him and fill our hearts with His Word.

A Sound and Stable Mind

2 Timothy 1:7

God has given believers power, love, and a sound mind. Fear is not from Him.

Isaiah 26:3

Perfect peace belongs to those whose minds are fixed on God and His promises.

Guarding and Directing the Mind

1 Peter 1:13

Believers are instructed to prepare and discipline their minds, placing their hope firmly in God's grace.

Luke 12:29

Jesus taught believers not to live with anxious minds, but to trust the Father's provision.

Romans 8:5

Those who live according to the Spirit set their minds on the things of the Spirit.

Romans 8:6

A spiritually minded life produces life and peace.

A Faithful and Devoted Mind

Matthew 22:37

Believers are called to love God with all their heart, soul, and mind.

Acts 17:11

A noble mind eagerly receives God's Word and studies the Scriptures daily.

Acts 20:19

Serving the Lord involves humility of mind and devotion to His purpose.
